

Letter from the President, WVLBC – November 7, 2020

Dear WV Lawn Bowling Club Members,

SUSPENSION OF CLUB BOWLING ACTIVITIES UNTIL DECEMBER 1, 2020 DUE TO COVID-19 SPREAD RISK

The WVLBC Board has whole-heartedly agreed with the recommendation of the Indoor Bowling convenors to immediately suspend indoor bowling activities for three weeks, until the week of December 1, 2020.

In the past week we have seen COVID 19 infections rise dramatically in both the Fraser Valley and Metro Vancouver regions. Yesterday there were 500+ new cases in B.C.

The Public Health Officer has ordered businesses and recreation centres to stop holding indoor group physical activities for two weeks, including yoga, spin, dance, and group fitness classes. Indoor sports where physical distancing can't be maintained are suspended.

Although we are arguably not directly subject to the new orders, it is prudent to be cautious and pro-active. We expect this to be temporary, for as much time as is appropriate. Thank you for your understanding. Sorry folks, but this is the right move.
