COVID SAFETY PLAN, JUNE 25, 2021

West Van Lawn Bowling Club (“WVLBC” or “the Club”) members attending the club grounds and/or facilities agree to comply with the provisions of this Covid Safety Plan as currently posted and as amended by the Board from time to time. This Safety Plan will be amended regularly as the Provincial Return to Sport 2.0 authority makes changes.

Waivers and Medical Screening – Simplified procedure

All club members continue to require a signed Waiver of Claims and Indemnity Agreement, and to confirm on each entry that they do not have any symptoms associated with COVID 19. The medical questionnaire process has been simplified with a Sign-in Book, with daily signature pages. Members entering their name on each daily visit are confirming that they do not have any of the COVID symptoms listed with the Sign-in Book.

1. All club members, including bowlers and monitors, must complete, date and sign a Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims and Indemnity Agreement respecting risks of harm arising from any club activity, including COVID-19 infection.
2. All club members must enter their name and the time, in the daily “Sign-up Book before participating in WVLBC activities. Entering their name confirms that they have no symptoms listed on the Symptom Screening Questionnaire form.

Masks, Social distancing and Personal Sanitation - Outdoors

1. Outdoor masking is optional. There are no Provincial Health Order (PHO) mask orders for outdoors. It is recommended that members wear a mask anywhere on the property when they are unable to maintain a safe distance from others (for example in pairs play or in croquet)
2. By PHO order, the maximum number of participants on the greens is 50, and the maximum number of spectators on the property is 50.
3. By PHO Order, there continues to be an outdoor 2 m. physical distancing requirement. The PHO order does not apply to the field of play, to allow for physical contact sports. The distance order does apply everywhere else on the grounds. Members are requested to maintain 2m distancing at all times.
4. The maximum number of players on a rink will continue to be 4 players (i.e. singles, pairs or cutthroat). Game conveners may allow larger groups in exceptional circumstances and with appropriate directions for safe play. For croquet the maximum group size is four players. A maximum of two player groups at a time may be on the field, with 15 minute separation between groups.
5. Members shall bring their own hand sanitizer and drinking water containers to the grounds. Members are requested to wash or sanitize their hands upon entry and exit to the grounds, and upon entry and exit from the clubhouse.
6. First members attending in the day please put out hand sanitizer at the entrance gate and at picnic table. Last members of the day, please put the sanitizer away.

Clubhouse and washroom facilities

1. Masks are to be worn at all times in the Clubhouse, by PHO order.
2. The maximum number of people in the clubhouse is ten (10).
3. The maximum number of people in the locker room at a time is two.
4. Social distancing of 2m must be observed indoors, at all times, by PHO Order.
5. The water fountain and kitchen continue to be closed.
6. Members are requested not to congregate in the clubhouse.
7. The Indoor washrooms are opened for use. A maximum of two people at a time in the washrooms only please, and members are requested to sanitize touched surfaces using the provided cleaners.

Scheduling of Play

1. Members will continue to book online for Draw events, tournaments and croquet, using the SignUp Genius application.
2. It is not necessary to schedule a practice time; members may attend on a drop-in basis for practices, on any day between 10:30 a.m. and 8:00 PM. (Members may want to continue to sign up for practice times as means of checking on lane availability, or letting friends know your plans, but there is no requirement to sign in or any booking process).
3. Members attending for “drop-in” play shall have regard for the PHO Order that there are only 50 participants allowed on the playing fields. If the fields are busy, please observe the limit. You can be a spectator on the grounds, while waiting for an opening.

Please note that as the fields are now marked for 8 lanes each, that allows for more people and the limit may be an issue. Members are asked to monitor and self-police observance of this limit.
