The Almost-Back-to-Normal Provincial Health Officer Order and Restrictions

On June 30 a new PHO order for Groups and Events was issued, and on July 1 new Province-wide restrictions were posted:

The short story is that all indoor & outdoor group sports are allowed; spectator limits have been relaxed, & there are no mandatory distancing, masking or number limits directed at sporting events. There is a transition from a "Covid Safety Plan" to a "Communicable Disease Plan". We have asked for & are waiting for word from the Provincial authority, viaSports, on how this Order is interpreted for Lawn Bowling, which usually comes a few days after the PHO order. We will inform you as soon as we know. In the meantime, please continue with reasonable behaviour.



- Please continue with the daily sign-in at the club,
- Remember to wash hands/sanitize upon entry to the ground and exit.
- Masks and distancing are recommended, especially indoors for persons not fully vaccinated.
- Please avoid congregating in the clubhouse. Try to keep it to ten persons maximum, with maximum of two persons in the locker room at a time.
- Continue to use SignUpGenius to book space for draws and croquet.
- If you are the first to arrive in the morning, please put the sanitizing equipment out on the upper and lower greens. Last to leave, return supplies to the inside of the Clubhouse.

Bowls BC tells us that interclub play is now allowed. Stay tuned for more information!
